



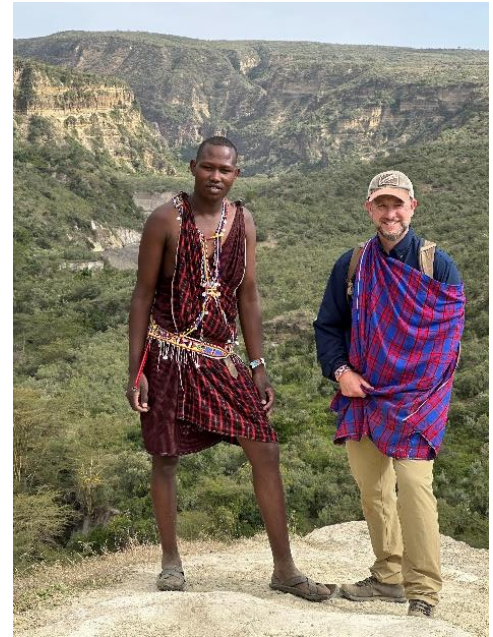
*A Trip of a Lifetime for You ...*

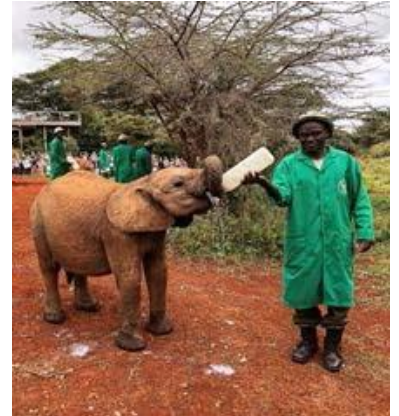
